## Talisman Energy Inc. Undergraduate Scholarships in Energy and Related Studies in Science

**Faculty:** Science

**Field of Study:** Geology/Geophysics or Students in other Science programs who feel they are studying in a substantially energy related area.

**Value:** \$10,000

**Number:** Seven

**Conditions:** Offered annually to continuing undergraduate students entering third or fourth year majoring in Geology or Geophysics in the Faculty of Science at the University of Calgary. Students in other Science programs who feel they are studying in a substantially energy related area are also encouraged to apply. The award is based primarily on academic merit. To be eligible, students must have completed coursework that focuses on the field of energy. The awards are also based on the preparation of an essay summarizing the student's interest in studying in the field of energy, the environment and the economy and demonstrated potential for advanced study and research in the field of energy, the environment and the economy. Students must also meet the following criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 3.20
- 4 Full Course Equivalents must have been completed during the Fall 2009/Winter 2010 sessions

**Apply:** **Submitted to the Dean's Office in the Faculty of Science by April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.** Applicants must submit an essay (maximum of 1000 words) summarizing their interest in studying in the field of energy, the environment and the economy and demonstrated potential for advanced study and research in the field of energy, the environment and the economy.

**Please note:** In order to ensure compatibility with award guidelines and avoid disappointment, students majoring in Science programs other than Geology or Geophysics must contact the Dean's Office in the Faculty of Science and receive written approval prior to application.
